

## CLAN MACLEAN HERITAGE TRUST

The First Meeting of the Trustees was held in Oban on Sunday 21st April 1996, at which were present the two existing trustees, both ex-officio, viz: the Hon Sir Lachlan Maclean of Duart and Morvern, Chief of the Clan Maclean, and the Very Reverend Allan Maclean of Dochgarroch ygr, President of the Clan Maclean Association.

It was agreed that Sir Lachlan Maclean should act as Chairman of the Trustees and the Very Reverend Allan Maclean should act as Secretary and Treasurer, until such time as the full complement of Trustees should be appointed and decide otherwise. It was also determined to open a Bank Account for the Trust, in order that the Trust may receive Funds and make Payments in a regular manner. It was resolved that the Bank of Scotland should be appointed bankers and that the said Bank be requested to honour all Cheques and Orders provided that such documents are signed by any two of the signatories; the signatories, for the time being, to be the Chairman and the Secretary/Treasurer.
