

CLAN MACLEAN HERITAGE TRUST

The Second Meeting of the Trustees was held in Tobermory on Friday 21st June 1996, at which were present all five trustees, viz: Sir Lachlan Maclean of Duart and Morvern, The Very Reverend Allan Maclean of Dochgarroch ygr, Alister D. McLean, Major Nicholas Maclean-Bristol and Ronald G MacLean.

Allan Maclean described the background to the setting up of the Trust and also what had happened at the First Meeting of the Trustees.

Sir Lachlan explained that he had nominated Alister D. McLean, 'Ardvar', 15 Larundel Road, City Beach 6015, Perth, Western Australia, as a Trustee for a two year period. Allan explained that the Council of the Clan Maclean Association had nominated Major Nicholas M. V. Maclean-Bristol, Breacachadh Castle, Isle of Coll, PA78 6TB, Scotland, to be a Trustee for a five year period, and Ronald G. MacLean, Napier House, 8 Colinton Road, Edinburgh EH10 5DS, Scotland, to be a Trustee for a four year period.

Allan explained that a Bank Account [00113869] had been opened at the Bank of Scotland, Oban, [801799], and the Treasurer of the Clan Maclean Association had transferred the balance of Funds in the Special Projects Fund [£3600] to it.

It was proposed by Allan Maclean, seconded by Ronald MacLean that Nicholas Maclean-Bristol should be the Chairman of the Trustees, which proposal was passed nem con. Nicholas accepted and said that he hoped that the Trust would be a useful agent for the Clan Maclean. He said that he would arrange a date and place for the next Meeting of the Trustees.
